

MEASLES / RUBELLA (MR) VACCINE	Added
TETAUS, DIPTHERIA, PERTUSSIS, (Tdap) VACCINE	Added
PCV (PNEUMOCOCCAL CONJUGATED VACCINE)	Retained
BCG VACCINE	Birth dose retained, repeat dose and catch-up dose added
REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA

13.7 Other Vaccines

Medicine/ Management	Decision
HUMAN PAPILOMA VIRUS (HPV)	Amended Amended from two dose to a single dose (HPV)
VACCINE	Vaccine schedule for girls ≥9 years
