17.2.1 Croup (Laryngotracheo Bronchitis) in Children

ADRENALINE	Dose amended The dose of adrenaline 1:1000 has been amended to allow for a minimum volume of 4mL to be added to the nebuliser's reservoir to accommodate for the 'dead volume' (residual drug solution that cannot be nebulised which results in wastage of the drug).
