DESCRIPTION

8.1 Chronic Kidney Disease

Medicine/ Management	Decision
FUROSEMIDE, Oral/IV	Amended
	Furosemide, oral or IV, 20mg to 80mg daily, as a single or in divided doses





Medicine Amendments continued



DESCRIPTION

8.4 Urinary Tract Infection (UTI)

Medicine/ Management	Decision
FOSFOMYCIN, Oral	Added 3g as a single dose-STG guidance was delineated to specifically provide guidance for pregnant women to minimise confusion.
NITROFURANTOIN, Oral	Added 100mg, 6 hourly for 5 days
